

PROFESSIONAL PULL

Pull Rental Terms

N.Cole® Jewelry and Nik Spruill Atelier

These Pull Rental Terms, together with the private Approved Pull Summary issued for the applicable request number, constitute the complete agreement between Nik Spruill / N.Cole® (the "Brand") and the stylist or responsible party identified in that summary (the "Stylist"). The Approved Pull Summary identifies the approved pieces, retail values, fees, shipping charges, approved use, delivery details and return deadline. If a transaction-specific term in the Approved Pull Summary differs from these general terms, the Approved Pull Summary controls for that request.

01 Approval and acceptance

A pull request is an application only and does not reserve any piece. A request becomes confirmed only after the Brand issues an Approved Pull Summary, the Stylist accepts these terms and the summary electronically, and all amounts due are paid through the secure payment link. Unless the summary states otherwise, approval expires 48 hours after the approval email is sent. The Brand may approve or decline any request and may limit or withdraw pieces that are unavailable, damaged, fragile or otherwise unsuitable for release.

02 Ownership and approved use

All approved garments, jewelry and accessories (the "Pieces") remain the Brand's sole property unless a separate purchase is completed and confirmed in writing. The Stylist receives temporary possession only for the client, project, event, purpose and dates shown in the Approved Pull Summary. The Pieces may not be loaned, rented, sold, pledged, transferred or used for another client or project without the Brand's prior written approval. No intellectual-property, merchandising or endorsement rights are transferred.

03 Fees, shipping and secure payment

The standard non-refundable pull rental fee is 35% of the approved retail value of each Piece, unless the Approved Pull Summary states a different approved amount. The Stylist is responsible for insured outbound and return shipping and any approved rush, duty or carrier charges. Payment information is collected and stored only through the Brand's approved secure payment provider; card numbers and security codes must not be entered in the pull request, this document or ordinary email. Payment of a pull rental fee does not purchase a Piece and is not credited toward a purchase unless the summary expressly says so.

04 Custody, delivery and return shipping

The Stylist is responsible for the Pieces from pickup or carrier acceptance until the Brand receives and inspects the return. This responsibility includes possession by the client, assistants, production personnel, venues, carriers and other third parties. Returns must be sent by the deadline and by a trackable service insured for the retail values shown in the Approved Pull Summary. The Stylist must provide return tracking promptly. A carrier scan alone does not establish that the correct Pieces were returned in acceptable condition.

05 Care and alterations

The Stylist must protect every Piece from stains, cosmetics, fragrance, moisture, smoke, adhesives and excessive wear. No Piece may be cut, pinned through, tailored, resized, polished, cleaned, repaired or otherwise altered without the Brand's prior written approval. Tags, closures, components and identifying marks may not be removed or changed. Only the Brand may authorize cleaning, repair or alteration.

06 Return deadline, inspection and extensions

Every Piece must be shipped or delivered back by the return deadline in the Approved Pull Summary. An extension is valid only if the Brand approves it in writing before the deadline and confirms any additional fee. The Brand may inspect returned Pieces before closing the transaction and will provide written notice of any material loss, damage, alteration, missing component, extraordinary cleaning requirement or late return identified during inspection.

07 Loss, theft, damage and non-return

The Stylist is responsible for loss, theft and physical damage during the custody period. Repairable damage, extraordinary cleaning, missing components and unauthorized late retention may be charged at the reasonable documented cost. For a Piece that is lost, stolen, not returned, materially altered, destroyed or damaged beyond reasonable repair, the Brand may charge up to the full retail value listed in the Approved Pull Summary. Before an additional charge, the Brand will send written, itemized notice identifying the affected Piece and the amount. The Stylist's required payment authorization permits the secure payment method saved for the approved pull to be charged for amounts properly due under these terms. Pull rental fees and shipping charges remain non-refundable, and an additional charge does not transfer ownership unless the Brand separately confirms a purchase in writing.

08 Cancellation, substitution and release

Paid fees are non-refundable except when the Brand withdraws an unavailable Piece before release and no accepted substitute is provided. In that case, the Brand will refund the fee received for that Piece, but not third-party costs the Brand did not receive. The Brand is not required to release Pieces until acceptance, payment and any specifically requested insurance documentation are complete.

09 Designer credit, images and confidentiality

The Stylist will use commercially reasonable efforts to provide the correct designer credit wherever credits are within the Stylist's or client's control: "Nik Spruill Atelier, @nikspruillbrand" for womenswear and "N.Cole® by Nik Spruill, @nikspruillbrand" for jewelry. Available publication links, tearsheets, photographs and credit information should be sent to melissa.hill@nikspruill.com within five business days after public release. The Brand will treat non-public client and project information as confidential and use it to review and administer the pull. Publicly released images will be reposted only when the Brand has the necessary permission, and neither party may imply a celebrity, client, publication or production endorsement without separate written approval.

10 Electronic agreement and general terms

By completing both required acknowledgments on the private Approved Pull Summary, the Stylist confirms that the Stylist reviewed and agrees to these Pull Rental Terms and that summary, intends to sign electronically, and authorizes the documented charges described above. The Brand may retain the request number, agreement version, accepted summary, date and time of acceptance, submitted identity information and payment confirmation as the transaction record. The Stylist may download or retain a copy. Changes, extensions, waivers or purchase options must be confirmed in writing. If one provision is unenforceable, the remaining provisions continue in effect; waiver of one breach does not waive another. These terms and the Approved Pull Summary replace prior communications about the approved pull.

Electronic acceptance is completed on the private Approved Pull Summary. No separate signature page is required.
